HOMEMADE SLUSHIE SLIME

Have you ever been really stressed or bored? Well here's an awesome slime to help you relieve anxiety and cure boredom! The things you will need are...

An airtight container

A bottle of Elmer's Clear School Glue

About $\frac{1}{4}$ a cup of water

$\frac{1}{2}$ tsp of baking soda

Contact solution

Food coloring (optional)



Slushie beads

A mixing utensil

A bowl

Mix a whole bottle of glue, your water, baking soda, and if you want food coloring in your bowl. Then slowly and carefully put contact solution in your mixture little by little. The slime will start to form and it will be done when it pulls away from the sides of the bowl. When done with the slime, leave it a little bit sticky so the slushie beads will stick to it. Then put your slushie beads in the bowl(which you can find at Michaels or Hobby Lobby) and put your slime in the bowl. Mix and knead the slime into the beads until the slime is no longer sticky and all the beads are in it. Store it in an airtight container so it won't dry out, and there you go! You have your own homemade slushie slime!
